



ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON BURKE STREET AT ITS INTERSECTIONS WITH NEWBURY STREET AND MAJOR DRIVE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eight

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article III “Stop and Yield Intersections”, Section 320-4 “Stop intersections”, subsection (d) of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language:

“§ 320-4. Stop intersections.

...

D. The following intersections are hereby designated as stop or through streets, and authority is hereby granted for the erection of a stop sign at the corner so designated in accordance with the tenor of this chapter:

Stop Sign on	Sign Location	At Intersection of

<u>Burke Street</u>	<u>Northeast corner</u>	<u>Newbury Street</u>
<u>Burke Street</u>	<u>Southwest corner</u>	<u>At its easterly intersection with Major Drive”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of installation of the appropriate sign(s).
