Staff Items:

The Board discussed the application for a 2005 religious exemption filed by the Heritage Baptist Church (Account #13214). At the last meeting the Board asked Pastor Hileman, of the Heritage Baptist Church, to provide them with a copy of the Certificate of Occupancy issued by the Building Department and the Place of Assembly Permit, issued by the Fire Marshall's Office. These have been received and they were both issued in July, 2005. After a brief discussion, the Board decided to stand by their prior denial of this religious exemption, as the requirements in RSA 72:23 were not met as of April 1, 2005.

Chief Assessor Angelo Marino updated the Board on the status of the installation of Patriot assessing software and the 2005 update of assessments. He said we were having some issues with conversion of data and now the tables just need to be calibrated and the values appropriately assessed. He advised he would like to have this all taken care of this week and be able to work on the update next week. Chair Blaisdell asked if next meeting the Board can be given a preview of the updated assessments. Chief Assessor Angelo Marino concurred. He said he has been working on this extensively during the week and also on weekends. He is working closely with Commercial Appraiser Robert Lakeman. He said that Patriot has made a lot of help available to us and also are getting a quick response from Patriot when help is needed. Chair Marylou Blaisdell said that she would like to make sure that we are in cohesive agreement in how we update the Aldermen with this information.
