At the last meeting Mr. Marino said he would look into the IRS booklet received by the Board from a taxpayer, which Dominic D'Antoni asked about at the last meeting. The taxpayer did not identify himself nor state the relevance of this booklet in his note to the Board or staff when he dropped off the booklets.

Chief Assessor Angelo Marino advised the Board that David Connell, Corporation Counsel, will be assisting the Board of Assessors with drafting a letter releasing the authority to the Board of Aldermen to determine whether the Nashua Ice Commission, dba Conway Arena should be exempt from property taxes for the property located at 8 Riverside Street (Map E/Lot 1359).

Chief Assessor Angelo Marino told the Board that the Patriot Software session was successful and, although he hasn't gotten feedback from other participants, the Assessing staff felt it was user-friendly and helped them to better understand how to use the software. Chair Blaisdell commented that she likes the new property record cards.
